### Summary of week's activities

- Each day will begin with a large group gathering including songs, yoga and parachute activities
- Daily nature exploration through daily short hikes/walks and scavenger hunts
- Active participation in gardening including weeding, planting, harvesting and preparation of foods from our expansive garden
- Nature based arts and crafts
- Exposure to a variety of farm animals and daily farm chores (feeding the animals, brushing animals, collecting eggs etc.)
- Daily hands on snack prepared within the routine by the participants (homemade lemonade, applesauce, salad from the garden, salsa, )
- Closing group with songs and review of day's activities

Each participant will be paired with a "helper" (peer model, adult, junior counselor) to assist with participation and facilitation of social interactions as well as assistance and encouragement to explore the environment and the materials available. Visual supports ( PECS) will be provide for all activities as needed by each individual including social stories, visual schedules, prompts and cues. The goal for this session is for all the children to enjoy a nature based, child directed, adult facilitated summer program with a strong emphasis on expanding and building social connections and group participation .Children of all abilities and ages are encouraged and welcomed!
